Study Summary	<p>Alba Science is inviting you to take part in a study for people who suffer with dandruff/Dry Scalp. The purpose of this study is to compare the effects of two anti-dandruff shampoos and a shampoo containing no antidandruff properties. They will be measured by a decrease in dandruff flakes over a 4 week test phase.</p> <p><u>Visit 1 – Consent and Screening</u></p> <p>You will be asked to provide written consent of your agreement to take part in this study. If you are accepted onto the study after the health screening procedure, you will undergo a scalp assessment. If you are eligible to continue you will be given an appointment for Visit 2 and will be provided with a marketed shampoo to use in place of your regular product, until this visit. You will be permitted to use your own conditioner and styling products as long as it does not contain any anti-dandruff properties.</p> <p><u>Visit 2 – Re-qualification</u></p> <p>Please attend the test centre having washed your hair approximately 48 (± 4 hours) hours prior to your appointment. This visit will take approximately thirty minutes. The purpose of this visit is to ensure that you have enough dandruff on your scalp to participate in the study after using the supplied beauty shampoo for the last few weeks.</p> <p>Your scalp will be visually assessed by test personnel to establish if you still meet the study criteria. If not, you will be provided with a cheque for £40 for your participation.</p> <p>If still suitable, you will be given an appointment from visit 3 and requested not to wash your hair for 48 hours (+ 4 hours) before this visit. You should note that after visit 3, you will only have your hair washed at the test centre until study completion.</p>																		
Attendance – Maximum 15 Visits	<p><u>You will be required to attend one of the screening visits and one of the requalification visits. Appointments will run throughout each day.</u></p> <p><u>Visit 1</u></p> <p>Tuesday 13 March 2018 – Friday 16 March 2018 – Please choose <u>ONE</u> day that you can attend during this week.</p> <p><u>Visit 2</u></p> <p>Tuesday 03 April 2018 – Friday 06 April 2018 - Please choose <u>ONE</u> day that you can attend during this week.</p> <p>At visit 2 your scalp will be visually assessed by test personnel to establish if you still meet the study criteria. Inclusion Criteria	<p><u>Inclusion Criteria</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Male or Females. 2. Aged 18 to 65 years inclusive. 3. Current users of either beauty shampoo or zinc pyrithione anti-dandruff shampoo and/or anti-dandruff products. 4. Subjects who have not permed or chemically straighten their hair in the past month. 5. Be willing and able to read and sign an Informed Consent Form and carry out all study procedures as described in the subject information sheet. 6. Be prepared not to have straightening and other chemical treatments for the duration of the study. 7. Are willing not to take part in any hair or scalp study for any other company for the duration of the trial. 8. Fitzpatrick skin type I, II or III. Light Coloured skin. 		
Exclusion Criteria	<p><u>Exclusion Criteria</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Have a history of serious illness that may require regular systemic medication which may influence the outcome of the study. 2. Regular use of any medication/topical products that may affect the outcome of the study. 3. Suffering from hair loss with Savin grade 2 or over (female) and Hamilton grade IV and over (male). 4. Have ever during adult life had psoriasis on any part of the body. 5. Have had eczema on any part of the body in the last five years. 6. Have any other active skin conditions on any part of the body. 7. Have cuts, broken skin or irritation on the scalp (as assessed by scalp assessor at screening). 8. Use of topical steroids on the scalp currently or within 6 months of start of study. 9. Current use of systemic or inhaled steroids. 10. Known allergies or sensitivities to shampoo. 11. Users of ketoconazole based shampoo (Nizoral, Neutrogena Long Lasting) selenium sulphide based shampoo (Selsun, L'Oreal Intensive, Head & Shoulders Intensive) in the last 3 months. 12. Female only – pregnant or breast feeding. 		

Study Restrictions	<p><u>Volunteers will be requested to observe the following restrictions during the course of their participation in the study:</u></p> <p>Not to have your hair chemically treated (e.g. coloured, permed or chemically straightened) during the salon phase of the study. During the wash-in phase you will be allowed to dye your hair once.</p> <p>Not to have your hair cut during the study.</p> <p>Not too wet your hair for a least 12 hours before the visual assessment visits.</p> <p>You will be requested to use the wash-in beauty shampoo at home in place of your normal shampoo between visits 1 and 3. You will be allowed to use your normal conditioner providing the conditioner contains no AD actives and styling products during the wash-in period.</p> <p>You will be instructed to perform your final hair wash 48 hours (\pm 4 hours) before visits 2 and 3 and requested not to apply styling products after your last wash before your visits.</p> <p><u>After visit 3, you will be asked:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To keep appointment schedule so that the study products will be applied according to protocol. • Not to wash or wet your hair at any other time other than in the site salon for the duration of test phase. You will be allowed to go swimming if they wear a bathing cap. • Not to use any hair care products, treatments or styling products at any time for the duration of the test phase (for example, styling gel or hairspray).
Expenses	<p>You will be paid <u>£40 expenses</u> if you only complete visits 1 & 2. -</p> <p>If you complete all 15 visits you will receive <u>£200 expenses</u> at the end of the study.</p>
